



**CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE – TOP RAIL, BOTTOM RAIL, POSTS, PICKETS  
(ALL RAILING SERIES)**

Railings shall be cleaned with water and a mild soap or detergent, then rinse with clean water. Do not use steel wool, acid solutions or harsh abrasives.

All railing surfaces require periodic washing to maintain peak aesthetics. Especially those which are subject to harsh chemical environments.

If tree sap, insects, or other similar deposits have accumulated on the railing, wash as soon as possible.

If you detect any scratches in the paint, touch them up. Your dealer has touch-up paint to match the color of your railing.

Waxing painted surfaces after washing is recommended.

Repair anodized finishes according to NAAMM Metal Finishes Manual.

**CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE – STAINLESS STEEL CABLES (SERIES 2000 AND  
SERIES 5C RAILING ONLY)**

Regularly clean stainless-steel cables on a similar schedule to cleaning of top rail, bottom rail, and post components to maintain peak aesthetical form.

Several cleaners are recommended for stainless steel and any are viable for cleaning cables. We recommend E-Z clean which both cleans and protects. How frequently cleaning should take place varies dramatically. In general, harsh chemical environments or those near salt water will need cleaned more frequently.

Please DO NOT use steel wool or harsh abrasive elements to clean stainless steel cables.
